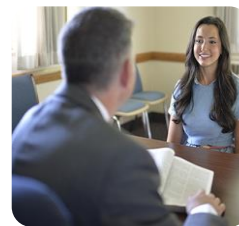


Anderson Stake Ministering & Resources to Meet Individual and Family Needs



Individual Ministering Efforts

- Give Christlike love
- Identify needs
- Solve needs as able
- Get help with more complex or prolonged needs

Elders Quorum/ Relief Society Presidencies

- Address needs that require more resources
- Use Ward, Stake, Church & Community Support available through Google Doc or Opportunity Center; related resources
- Report needs met on Google Doc; Refer and/or Report to Bishop
- Seek additional help/make referral to Bishop and/or Opportunity Center as needed

Bishop

- Uses keys to determine need for ward resources: Bishop's Storehouse, Counselling, etc.
- Utilizes Opportunity Center and Google Docs to find resources; Document needs met
- Asks for additional help from the Opportunity Center as needed

Examples of needs individuals might take care of:

- Dinner/other help needed post-surgery
- Ride to Dr. appointment
- Childcare: parents to temple
- Intermittent companionship

Examples of needs EQ/RS might address:

- Furniture, Appliances, Home Repair as appropriate
- Supportive Care for longer term illness
- Mental Health issues
- Ongoing Transportation
- Employment/Job Training

Needs Bishop might address:

- Support the needs of the youth
- Temporal needs- keys to: Bishop's Storehouse, financial assistance
- Spiritual counseling and support for those specifically needing the Bishop's help
- Consider approval for other Church Social Services or related resources
