- <u>Medi-Cal</u>

- <u>Medi-Cal Access Program</u> (MCAP): For women who don't have insurance to cover pregnancy and are not receiving no-cost Medi-Cal or Medicare Part A and Part B, or have other health insurance plan that doesn't cover maternity services or with a maternity-only deductible or copayment greater than \$500.
